

WAYS TO GLORIFY GOD

Self-sacrifice (2 Cor 5:15) – living no longer for ourselves, but for Him who died for us.

Preference (Josh 24:15) – choosing to serve the Lord rather than following the world

Obedience (John 14:21) – demonstrate a heart filled with love for God by obeying .

Humility (Phil 2:5-9) – be humble before God, so Christ may be exalted in all things.

Confessing Jesus as Lord (Phil 2:10-11) – every knee will bow and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord; do it this side of heaven.

Confessing sin (Josh 7:19) – don't hide sins, confess them.

Trusting in God (Ro 4:20) – believe God; we do not waiver.

Praising God (Ps145:1-13) – acknowledge God, know His attributes, and give Him praise!

Giving thanks (Lk 17:11-18) – count blessings; we have much to give Him thanks for.

Ministering to others (1 Pet 4:10-11) – be a good steward of gifts God has given.

Proclaiming the Word (2 Thess 3:1) – the Word of God bring glory to His name

Moral purity (1 Cor 6:18-20) – flee from sins to glorify God in body and in spirit.

Winning people to Christ (2 Cor 4:7-15, Ro]15:9) – Share the gospel of Christ so people turn from sin to the Savior.

Bearing fruit (Jo 15:7-8) – show forth right attitudes and actions

Boasting (Galatians 6:14) – boast in the cross of Jesus .

Suffering (I Pet 4:14-16) – when we suffer reproach for His name, we glorify God.

Praying (John 14:13) – pray in the will and for the will of Christ.

Preserving unity (Ro15:5-7) – be like-minded in Christ, and in His Word.

Proclaiming His praises (1 Pet 2:9) – make known the “praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light”

Remembering (1 Cor 11:26) – by observing the Lord’s Table and remembering all God has done for us.
